



## 1<sup>st</sup> supplementary call for applications of students of FAT USB for summer schools financed from the PPSŘ programme in the calendar year 2026

Categories of mobilities:

- 1) **Summer schools:** 2 placements: subsidy 10.000 CZK/mobility (5 working days minimum)

### **Conditions for participation in the selection procedure:**

- At the time of departure and throughout the entire mobility period, the student must be duly enrolled in a Bachelor's, Master's, or PhD study programme; the studies must not be interrupted or terminated
- In the case of repeated mobility, the following rule applies: each student may complete study placements and/or traineeships for a total duration of up to 12 months per study cycle; previous mobilities within the same cycle are counted towards this limit.
- The **application** for the selection procedure is **binding**, meaning that if the student cancels the mobility, it may affect their future Erasmus+ application.

### **APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS**

- 1) DULY COMPLETED mobility application form. Available for download at: <https://www.fzt.jcu.cz/en/international-relations/outgoing-mobilities> (fill the form labelled "student")
- 2) Motivation letter
- 3) Proof of the applicant's language competence in the relevant foreign language (i.e., the language of instruction at the host institution), e.g. completion of an entry language test or exam at a minimum level of B1 within the study programme, an international certificate, OLS test (EU Academy), etc.
- 4) For Bachelor's and Master's students: Study Record Sheet A (weighted average grade)
- 5) Invitation letter (confirmation of acceptance) from the host institution; supervisor's statement (for PhD students)





## CRITERIA AND SCORING

### Bachelor and Master's students

1	Year of study	Priority is given to students in higher years of study	Max 10 points
2	Relevant motivation letter / connection to the field of study		Max 10 points
3	Weighted average grade		Max 20 points
4	Level of language competence (Language of instruction during the stay abroad)	Minimum: B1	Max 8 points
5	Mobility order	Priority is given to students going on mobility for the first time	Max 6 points

An applicant may obtain a maximum of 54 points; to be selected, at least 20 points are required.

### Ph.D. students

1	Year of study	Priority is given to students in higher years of study	Max 8 points
2	Relevant motivation letter / connection to the field of study		Max 10 points
3	Invitation letter / Confirmation of acceptance from the host institution		Max 8 points
4	Supervisor's support		Max 8 points
5	Level of language competence	Minimum: B1	Max 6 points

The results of the selection procedure, which is within the competence of FAT USB—i.e. the ranking of applicants—are governed by the resulting scores, see the individual items listed above. **The results of the selection procedure will be sent to all applicants by email.**
